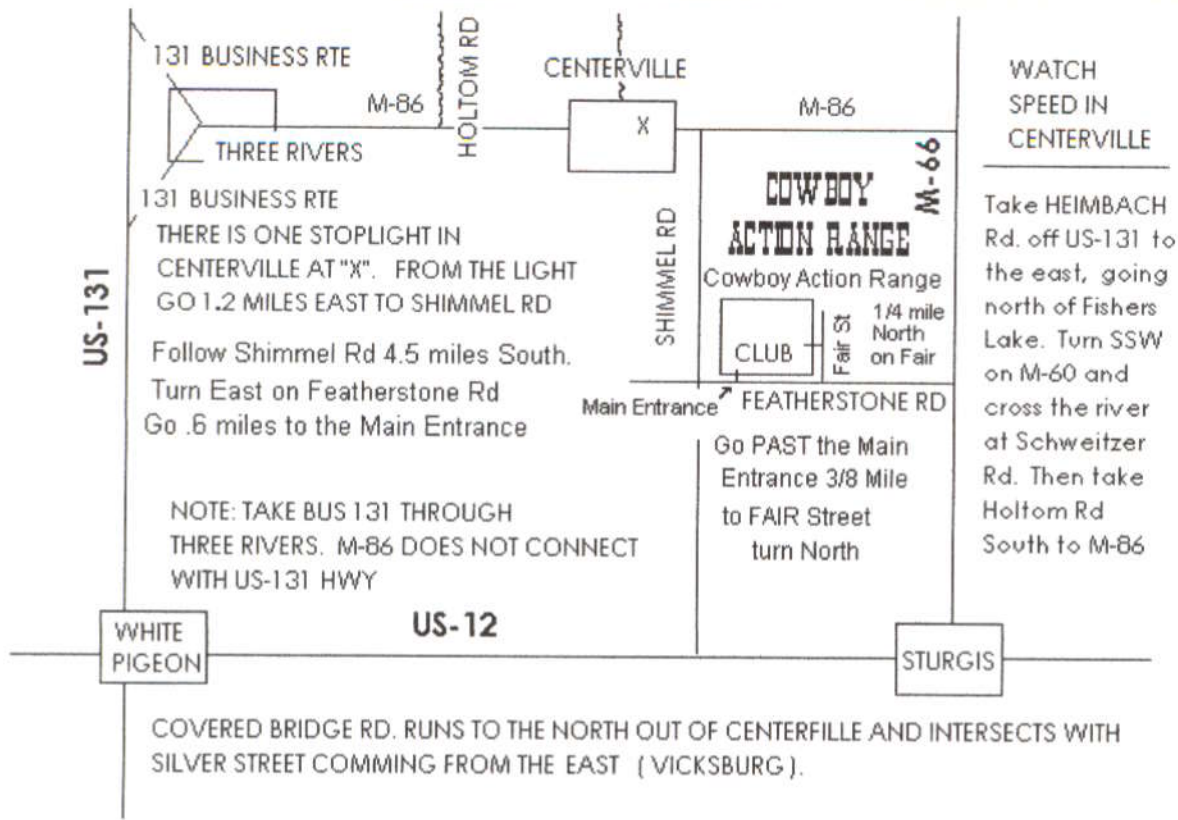


## St. Joseph County Sportsmen's & Conservation Club HIDDEN VALLEY COWBOYS Cowboy Action Shooting for 2007

**Side Matches:** Speed rifle/Speed pistol/Speed shotgun/22Combo will be available after the shooter has registered. There is also a 150 yd. Side Match for long range rifles: Single Shot, and Lever guns in 45-70, 38-55, etc.

**Local Rules:** Eyes/Ears REQUIRED for everyone on a live range at all times at SJCCC and this INCLUDES specatators.

Basic Requirements: "SASS Rules Apply".

- Two single action revolvers, 32 to 45 caliber, Blackhawks are OK in Modern or any age/gender Category;
- Lever action Cowboy rifle in a pistol caliber 25WCF to 45 Colt;
- Gunbelt and holsters;

- Cowboy costume: hat, boots, jeans, and a flannel shirt; no tennis shoes, ball caps, t-shirts or shorts;
- Hearing and vision protection required for everyone;
- double barrel shot gun 20 to 10 ga with extractors (not ejectors ) or Winchester 97 or Winchester 87;
- 75 rds pistol ammo, 75 rds rifle ammo and 50 rds shotgun;
- Pistol ammo must be all lead max. velocity 1000 fps.
- Rifle ammo must be all lead, max. velocity 1400 fps.
- Shotgun ammo: use No. 7 1/2 or No. 8 shot no magnum loads.

### **Special Instructions for Drivers, Shooters, and Guests:**


The Main Entrance to the Club is about .6 miles east of Shimmel Rd on Featherstone Rd on your left as you are heading East. Access to the Cowboy Action Range is off Fair Street. Continue East on Featherstone rd. about 3/8 mile to **FAIR ST** turn North and continue another 1/4 mile approximately. The Gate for the Cowboy Action Range will be marked for you on your left which is the west side of Fair St. Follow the 2-track about 1/4 mile to the Parking Area which is the large clearing to your left that you will come up on. Park anyplace. The Cowboy Action Range is down the trail about 1/4 mile. You can walk it but it's steep at the top. We will have our "Featherstone Express Stage" which is a tractor and wagon operating during matches to provide transportation for shooters. You catch the Featherstone Express right at the top of the trail before it goes down the hill. GW.
